Fireworks

With the approaching July 1st long weekend, we would like to remind everyone that fireworks are no longer permitted at Little Bow Resort in accordance with the policy put in place by the Board last year.

Also Vulcan County currently has a "Fire Advisory" in effect.

It should also be noted that setting off of fireworks on Crown Land i.e. the shoreline lease or Travers Reservoir, is strictly prohibited under the regulations set by Alberta Environment and sustainable Resource Development.

New Campground Lot Reservation Policy

The public cannot reserve a camping spot at LBR. Owners can make reservations for their guests. For an owner to make a reservation, they call the reservation in to the caretaker (403-792-2108). A reserved sign will not be placed on the campsite or campsites until the payment is received. Once the payment is received, a camp spot will be posted as reserved. If the reservation is cancelled 72 hours prior to the date reserved, the owner will receive a full refund. If the reservation is cancelled within the 72 hour period, there will be no refund. If there is no cancellation and no one shows up, there will be no reimbursement. The reservation is not confirmed until it is paid in full to the caretaker. In the case of a double booking, the reservations goes to the first person to make the payment.
