



FIRE BAN

No open fires are allowed in campgrounds or in backcountry or random camping areas. All fire permits are suspended or cancelled and no new fire permits will be issued.

There is currently a Fire Ban in the County of Vulcan as there is in most of Southern Alberta.

The following items are allowed :

BBQ's - fueled by propane and charcoal briquettes.

Fire Pits – propane fueled fires in fire pits that are considered “acceptable fire pits” under the County By-Law.

The following items are **not** allowed:

No Open Fires

Wood Fires – wood fires are not allowed even contained in fire pits.

Burn Barrels

Fireworks

Under the extremely dry conditions and high heat that we have been experiencing please be extra cautious. Please ensure that cigarettes and other smoking materials are extinguished in a fire proof container, containing water or sand. Do not ride ATVs in tall grass or areas with combustible materials. Make sure that your ATV muffler has a spark resistor.
